POW WOW is the Whitby Area annual cub camp held each Fall. This year the camp is the weekend of **Sept 30 - Oct 2 at Camp Samac**, in Oshawa. Our theme for this year is "**Letting in the Jungle**" and we'll be immersing the cubs in the world of the Jungle Books.

Cubs will be introduced to many of the stories from the Jungle Books and will have fun playing games and doing activities that are all related to the jungle environment. They will rescue Mowgli from the Banderlog, explore the lair of the White Cobra, and shoot arrows like the Gond Warriors.

We are inviting **ALL CUBS** to attend **POW WOW**. Being right at the beginning of the season, this may be too much-too soon for some of your cubs, especially your new Cubs. It will be a full weekend of activities and the youth will be on the go non-stop. The last thing we would want is for Pow Wow to be a bad experience for a youth and to jeopardize their cubbing year. We ask that Pack leaders use their best scouting judgement when registering youth for this camp; you are responsible for all youth that you bring to camp.

- The designated contact Leader is responsible for ensuring that only registered members are enrolled as participants.
- There are no picnic tables available on site.
- If your pack is twinning with another pack or you are sharing camping equipment, please send in with your registration package, a request (in writing) that you wish to camp together.
- There will be potable water at the site.
- Campfires are strictly prohibited.
- Special Needs Cases (incl. wheel chair): All special needs cases will be dealt with individually. Please make us aware of these cases with your registration package.
- No-Trace Camping will be required – Groups must leave the campsites cleaner than when you arrive, and you are required to take away all of your own garbage.
- Camp Samac will be available for set up at 5:00pm for leaders/helpers. Please have youth arrive for 7pm. Entry will be from the North Entrance (Conlin Rd).
- Parking is limited. Please keep the number of vehicles remaining at Camp Samac to a minimum. Vehicle parking will be located at Lower Lakeland.
- One vehicle (must not be moved) or trailer permitted to remain at campsite for overnight food storage etc.
